# A BILL

further to amend the Bombay City Civil Court Act, 1948.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Bombay City Civil Court Act, 1948, for the purposes hereinafter appearing; it is hereby enacted in the Seventy-fourth Year of the Republic of India, as follows:—

**1.** (*1*) This Act may be called the Bombay City Civil Court (Amendment) Short title. Act, 2023.

(2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification in the *Official Gazette*, appoint.

XXV Act, 2012" the words, figures and brackets "section 2 of the Bombay City of 2012. Mah. Civil Court (Amendment) Act, 2023" shall be substituted. of 2023.

Power to difficulty.

**4.** (1) If any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of the Bom. remove Bombay City Civil Court Act, 1948, as amended by this Act, the State XL of Government may, as occasion arises, by an order published in the Official <sup>1948.</sup> *Gazette*, do anything, not inconsistent with the provisions of the Bombay City Civil Court Act, 1948, as amended by this Act, which appears to it to be necessary or expedient for the purpose of removing the difficulty:

Provided that, no such order shall be made after the expiry of a period of two years from the date of commencement of this Act.

(2) Every order made under sub-section (1) shall be laid, as soon as may be, after it is made, before each House of the State Legislature.
