**CHAPTER - 1**

**Executive Summary**

During the year 2015-2016,

- (a) The Commission made six recommendations regarding appointments by promotion and transfer. (Chapter-7)
- (b) The Commission tendered advice in 138 cases related to disciplinary action involving 175 employees. (Chapter-7)
- (c) The Commission tendered advice in 23 cases relating to Recruitment Rules & Service matters. (Chapter- 7 & 8)
- (d) There was not a single case of non-acceptance of Commission's advice by the Government on officers. (Chapter-10)
- (e) Total 14 competitive examinations were conducted for which 509510 candidates were admitted and completed 9 examinations for 1648 posts. Total number of recommendations made in 2015-16 from competitive examinations was 5485. These recommendations include competitive examinations conducted in previous year but finalized in the year 2015-16. (Appendix-A(2))
- (f) The Commission conducted 19 screening tests. For these examinations total 119994 candidates applied and 65495 candidates appeared. Short-listing was done on the basis of performance in the screening test. (Chapter-3)
- (g) The Commission processed 112 requisitions for Direct Recruitment by interviews from various Departments involving 1215 posts and for these posts the commission received 42437 applications. The commission called 3622 candidates for interviews and 1039 candidates were recommended. (Chapter-3)
- (h) For the 5 Direct Recruitment cases, none was found suitable out of the candidates who applied. (Appendix -A(3))
- (i) The Commission recommended 512 candidates from the backward classes to fill up the 661 posts reserved for them through Direct Recruitment by interview. This does not include 124 backward class candidates recommended against unreserved posts. (Chapter-5)
- (j) The Commission recommended 2447 candidates from the backward class to fill up 2764 posts (excluding the posts from JMFC(Main) Exam-2014 and JMFC(Main) Exam-2015, where there is no reservation) reserved for them through competitive examinations. This does not include 567 backward class candidates recommended against unreserved posts. (Chapter-5)
- (k) The Commission completed 10 departmental examinations for officers and employees of various Departments of the State Government. Total 1504 candidates were admitted for the aforesaid examinations, 1248 candidates participated and 648 candidates cleared the examinations. (Chapter -6)
- (l) The Commission prepared or revised the syllabus or scheme of examination in respect of 28 different types of posts under Direct Recruitment / Competitive Examination. (Chapter 11)

**CHAPTER – 2****Comparative Summary of Work Load of Maharashtra Public Service Commission**

2.1 Maharashtra Public Service Commission came into existence on 1st May, 1960. The following functions are prescribed to the State Public Service Commission under Article 320 of the Constitution of India.

(a) Recruitment for all Civil Services and Civil posts by:

1. Written examination followed by Interview
2. Screening tests followed by Interview
3. Interview

(b) To conduct examinations for appointments to various services of the state.

(c) To advise the State Government on:

- i. Matters relating to the process of recruitment to various services,
- ii. The qualification of candidates for appointment to the services and principles to be followed in making promotions and transfers from one service to another,
- iii. Disciplinary matters related to Government servants,
- iv. Claims for reimbursement of legal expenses incurred by the Government servants while defending legal proceedings initiated against them for acts done or purporting to be done while performing their duties,
- v. Claims for award of injury/family pension to Government servants and,
- vi. Any other matter referred to the Commission by the Governor

(d) In addition, to the matters related to the State Government of Maharashtra, the Commission deals with the following other matters also: -

(i) Under section 80-B of the Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai Act, the Commission has been entrusted with the responsibility of advising in respect of the matters pertaining to: -

1. Appointments to posts of Executive Engineer and above under the control of the MCGM.

2. Appointments to posts of Secretary, Grade -A (I) in BEST Undertaking.

(ii) Conducting Departmental examinations for employees of certain Government Departments and tendering advice to the Government regarding other matters pertaining to the examinations.

2.2 The number of gazetted and non-gazetted posts on the establishment of the Commission is same as previous year. Detailed information of posts is given in **Appendix "E"**.

2.3 The Commission does not have its own premises for office. At present, the office of the Commission is situated at 5<sup>1/2</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> Floor, Cooperage Telephone Corporation Building, Maharshi Karve Road, Mumbai- 400 021 on rental basis and the examination hall of the Commission is at Vikrikar Bhavan, Mazgaon, Mumbai - 400010. In a progressive State like Maharashtra, Public Service Commission should have its own office premises.

**CHAPTER – 3****Direct recruitment to the posts under  
the State Government by Interview**

- 3.1 Direct recruitment by Interview is made for filling up vacancies that are not filled in through regular competitive examinations held by the Commission. The process of recruitment starts with the receipt of requisition from the Ministry/ Departments / Statutory Organisations / Corporations.
- 3.2 The Commission conducted interviews on 193 days in the year 2015-16. During this year, 864 meetings of the Commission were held. Total of 9791 candidates called for interview, out of that 8627 candidates were interviewed.
- 3.3 In the year 2015-16, the Commission conducted screening tests in respect of 19 different types of posts, for which 119994 candidates applied and 65495 candidates appeared.

3.4 During this year, action was completed in respect of 112 recruitment references for 1215 vacant posts, for which 42437 applications had been received, 3622 candidates were interviewed and 1039 candidates were recommended to the Government for appointment. A list of these cases is given in *Appendix A(1)*.

3.5 *Appendix A(4)* includes a list of 186 (183-General + 3-Special drive) cases, in respect of which action was in progress during this year.

3.6 A list of cases which is given in *Appendix-A(5)* includes the requisitions, which were either cancelled by Government or closed by the Commission for non-compliance of the queries within the specific period.

3.7 In 56 (General-54 and SD-2) cases, the Commission could not recommend any candidate or the required number of candidate, as no suitable candidate was available. A list of such posts is given in *Appendix A (3)*.

**CHAPTER – 5****Representation of candidates from Backward Classes.**

- 5.1 52% of total vacancies are reserved for the candidates belonging to Backward Classes. In addition, 15% and 3% of class-III vacancies are reserved for ex-servicemen and person with disability respectively. 30% posts are reserved for female candidates in each category.
- 5.2 The reservation for the sections of Backward Classes viz. Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, DT(A), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D), SBC and Other Backward Class is absolute and consequently no candidates belonging to other communities can be recommended for vacancies reserved for these sections if suitable candidates belonging to the respective sections are not available. If no suitable candidates are available to fill up the vacancies reserved for ex-servicemen, such posts are treated as unreserved and filled in on merit with candidates available from the respective category. If no suitable female candidates are available to fill the vacancies reserved for female candidates, such posts are filled in on merit with available male candidates from the respective category.
- 5.3 Out of total 1215 vacancies requisitioned by the Government for which recruitment was made directly by interview, 661 vacancies were reserved only for the Backward Class categories. Commission could not recommend candidates for 129 posts from Backward Class, as suitable candidates were not available. In 2015-16, the Commission recommended 512 candidates for backward class. This does not include 124 backward class candidates recommended against unreserved posts.
- 5.4 In case of posts for which recruitment was made on the basis of competitive examinations, out of 6054\* total posts for which recommendations were made in the year 2015-16, the posts reserved for the Backward Classes were 2764\* viz. SC-737, ST-431, DT(A)-165, NT(B)-161, NT(C)-214, NT(D)-120, SBC-100 and OBC-836. The Commission recommended total 5034\* candidates in year 2015-16 on the basis of competitive examinations, out of which 2447\* candidates recommended were from backward classes viz SC-614, ST-325, DT(A)-126, NT(B)-136, NT(C)-158, NT(D)-100, SBC-79 and OBC-909. This does not include 567 backward class candidates recommended against unreserved posts.

**CHAPTER- 6****Departmental Examinations Conducted by the  
Commission for the State Government Employees**

- 6.1 During year 2015-16, the Commission completed 10 departmental examinations for officers and employees of various departments of the State Government. Total 1504 candidates were admitted for the aforesaid examinations and 1248 candidates participated, out of which 648 candidates cleared the examinations. Details of these examinations are given in *Appendix D (Part I & II)*.
- 6.2 During year 2015-16 the Commission conducted 8 departmental examinations but the results of which were not finalized during the same year. Details given in *Appendix D (part III)*.
- 6.3 Details of departmental Examinations, which were due in 2015-16 but could not be held due to non-receipt of application or any other circumstances, are given in *Appendix D (Part IV)*.

In the above cases, the number of proposals on which action was in progress during this year was large, for one or more of the following reasons, viz the information supplied was incomplete, up to-date confidential records of the concerned officers were not made available to the Commission, the recruitment rules were not finalized, the seniority lists of the concerned officers was not made available, the information regarding finalization of the recruitment rules was not communicated to the Commission in time or forwarding of the proposal regarding select list of higher posts, without finalizing the select list of its lower posts.

### **Legal Matters**

7.2 During the year 2015-2016 in all 396 new petitions were filed, in which Commission was made a respondent along with the Government. Out of these petitions, 140 petitions have been finally decided by the Honorable Supreme Court, High Court / Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (MAT). These petitions pertain to seniority, appointments, promotions, selections and other service matters. 670 petitions were yet to be finally decided by the Hon'ble Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal / High Court / Supreme Court and the same are pending in legal section of the Commission. **CHAPTER – 8****Appointments to the posts under the Municipal Corporation of BrihanMumbai and BrihanMumbai Electric Supply and Transport Undertaking**

- 8.1 The Commission has been entrusted with the responsibility of advising the Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai on matter pertaining to the appointments for posts of Executive Engineer and above under section 80-B of the Mumbai Municipal Corporation Act. The Commission also advises the BrihanMumbai Electric Supply & Transport Undertaking in matter pertaining to the appointments to posts of Secretary, Grade -A (I)
- 8.2 During the year 2015-16, action was not completed in respect of 10 recruitment references for the vacant posts under the MCGM and BEST. A list of these cases are given in *Appendix C(1)*. List of 5 cases for which recommendations made by the Commission on the basis of interview for the posts under the Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai & Brihanmumbai Electric Supply and Transport Undertaking is given in *Appendix C(3)*. A list of cases wherein the Commission could not recommend requisite number of candidates is shown in *Appendix C(4)*.
- 8.3 The table below shows the number of references relating to promotions and recruitment rules prescribed for posts, for the two organizations, within the purview of the Commission.

**CHAPTER 9****Posts/Services added or excluded from the purview of the Commission.**

- 9.1 The Maharashtra Public Service Commission (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations 1965, specify the posts, which fall within the purview of the Commission and it also specifies those posts, which have been exempted from the purview of the Commission. Exemption and inclusion of posts under the purview of the Commission requires prior sanction of Honourable, The Governor of Maharashtra.
- 9.2 There was no addition or exclusion of posts or services from the purview of the Commission during the year 2015-2016.

**CHAPTER 10****Acceptance and non-Acceptance of the  
advice of the Commission**

- 10.1 Article 320 of the constitution illustrates the matters on which the Commission shall be consulted. However it is not binding on the Government to act on the advice tendered by the Commission. Article 323 (2) of the constitution makes it mandatory for the Commission to report to Hon'ble, the Governor of Maharashtra on the matters where the advice of Commission was not accepted by the Government.
- 10.2 During the year, for all cases the advice tendered by the Commission was accepted by the Government, MCGM and BEST Undertaking.

**CHAPTER-11****Miscellaneous Matters****11. Examination Schemes and Syllabus:**

Whenever any advertisement is published by the Commission for Direct Recruitment and the number of prima-facie eligible applications received is disproportionately very large in comparison to the vacancies notified, then the Commission always decides to hold a screening test to short list the candidates for the interview.
