- १.२. मंडळाच्या हिशेब तपास्णीसाठी शासनाने नेमलेल्या हिशेब तपासनीसांचे प्रमाणपत्र र.र. मङळाच्या ाहराब तपासणासाठा शासनान नमलल्या ाहराब तपासनासाच प्रमाणपत्र तसेच सन २०१०-२०११ चे जमाखर्चाचे विवरणपत्र आणि ताळेबंद या अहवालासोबत जोडले काळातील आढावा त्यात घेण्यात आला आहे.
- मंडळाची स्थापना :- सुरक्षा रक्षक मंडळ बृहन्मुंबई आणि ठाणे जिल्ह्याकरिता हे मंडळ महाराष्ट्र खाजगी सुरक्षा रक्षक (नोकरीचे नियमन व कल्याण) अधिनियम १९८१ चे ह नडळ नहाराष्ट्र खाजागा सुरद्धा रक्षक (नाकराच ानयमन व कल्याण) आधानयम १५८१ च कलम ६(१) अन्वये प्रस्थापित झाले. महाराष्ट्र शासन, उद्योग, उर्जा व कामगार विभाग, अधिसूचना पारण वार / जालन अल्लामित शास्त्र, नहाराष्ट्र शास्त्र, ज्वान, ज्वान, ज्ञा प प्राप्तार क्षितार, जालपूर्वत क. एसजीए-१०८१/(१५४)/काम-१२, दि. १६ जुलै, १९८१ **अन्वये सुरक्षा रक्षक मंडळ** प्रतः एसजाए-२००२/१८५४)/प्राम-२२, १५. २५ जुल, १२०२ **अन्वय सुरक्षा रक्षक मडळ वृहनमुंबई आणि ठाणे जिल्हाकरिता** या मंडळाची स्थापना करण्यात आली. मंडळाचे प्रत्यक्ष
 - ३.९ सदर मंडळ त्रिस्तरिय संस्था असून त्यावर मालकांचे व सुरक्षा रक्षकांचे प्रतिनिधी **३.१** सदर मञ्ळ अस्तारय सस्या असून त्यायर मार्ट्यमय अ पुरक्षा त्यायमय आसानमा व राज्य शासनाचे प्रतिनिधी शासनामार्फत नेमले जातात. राज्य शासनाचे प्रतिनिधी म्हणून मंडळाचे
 - ३.२ महाराष्ट्र शासन,उद्योग, ऊर्जा व कामगार विभाग, अधिसूचना क एसजीए-२.र नहाराष्ट्र शासन,उधारा, जणा व कामगार विभाग, आवसूचना क्र.एसजाए-१५०७(८३)/काम-५,दि.१६.१०.२००७ अन्वये एकसदस्यीय मंडळाची स्थापना करण्यात आली. अध्यक्ष यांची नेमणूक करण्यात आली आहे.
 - **३.३.** अहवाल वर्षअखेरीस म्हणजे दि_. ३१.०३.२०११ अखेर विद्यमान सदस्यांची नांवे व इतर तपशील अहवालाच्या सुरुवातीस दिलेला आहे.

४. सुरक्षा रक्षक अधिनियम व अधिनियमाची उद्दीष्टे आणि प्रयुक्ती :-

- **४.१** महाराष्ट्र खाजगी सुरक्षा रक्षक (नोकरीचे नियमन व कल्याण) अधिनियम, १९८१ या अधिनियमास मा राष्ट्रपती यांची दि.२४ सप्टेंबर १९८१ रोजी अनुमती मिळाल्यानंतर, महाराष्ट्र शासनाने राजपत्र भाग-४ (असाधारण) दि. २५सप्टेंबर, १९८१ रोजी प्रसिद्ध केला.
- ४.२ अधिनियमाची उद्दीष्टे:- राज्यातील कारखाने व आस्थापनांमधून कामावर ठेवलेल्या खाजगी सुरक्षा रक्षकांच्या नोकरीचे नियमन करणे व त्यांच्या नोकरीच्या अटी व र्शातीं आणि कल्याण यासाठी आणि त्यांच्याशी संबंधित बाबींसाठी अधिक चांगल्या तरतूदी करणे.
- **४.३ प्रयुक्ती:** उक्त अधिनियम हा संपूर्ण महाराष्ट्र राज्यास लागू आहे. तथापि, सुरुवातीस या अधिनियमाची व्याप्ती फक्त बृहन्मुंबई आणि ठाणे जिल्ह्याकरिता मर्यादित केली होती. ज्या व्यक्तीने सुरक्षा रक्षक म्हणून खाजगी ठेकेदारामार्फत कोणत्याही कारखान्यात वा आस्थापनेत काम केले आहे. अशांना हा अधिनियम लागू होतो. परंतु जे सुरक्षा रक्षक कारखाना वा आस्थापना यांच्यामार्फत नियमित कामगार म्हणून कार्यरत आहेत त्यांना या अधिनियमांतर्गत तरतूदी लागू होत नाही.
- ४.४. अधिनियमांतर्गत सूट: न्यायालयाच्या निर्देशानुसार शासनाने महाराष्ट्र खाजगी सुरक्षा रक्षक (नोकरीचे नियमन व कल्याण) अधिनियम, १९८१ चे कलम २३ अंतर्गत काही अटी व शर्तींच्या अधिन राहून खाजगी सुरक्षा रक्षकांना सन २००३ पासून तीन वर्षाच्या कालावधीसाठी सूट देण्याचे धोरण अवलंबिले आहे.

५ . अधिनियमांतर्गत योजना : -

उक्त अधिनियमाचे कलम ३(१) अन्वये कारखाने व आस्थापना यासाठी सुरक्षा रक्षकांचा पुरेसा पुरवठा व्हावा, सुरक्षा रक्षकांना नियमीत नोकरी मिळावी, नोकरीतल्या अटी व शर्ती याकरिता अधिक चांगली तरतूद करण्यासाठी खाजगी सुरक्षा रक्षक (नोकरीचे नियमन व कल्याण) योजना, १९८१ दिनांक १.१०.१९८१ पासून लागू करण्यात आली.

ही योजना बृहन्मुंबई आणि ठाणे जिल्ह्यातील मंडळाच्या नोंदीत कारखाने किंवा नोंदीत आस्थापना नोंदणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षक ठेवतात अशांना लागू होते. योजनेचे खंड १४ व १५,दि.१ऑक्टोबर १९८१ पासून अंमलात आले व उर्वरित खंड दि.१ नोव्हेंबर,१९८१ पासून अंमलात आली. मूळ योजना राबविण्यास दि.१ ऑक्टोबर,१९८१ पासून सुरुवात झाली. सुधारीत योजना सन २००२ पासून अंमलात आली आहे.

६. मंडळाची कार्ये:-

उक्त अधिनियम व त्याखालील योजनेचे खंड-२ मध्ये निर्देश केलेली उद्दीष्टे पार पाडण्याकरीता इष्ट वाटतील अशा उपाययोजना करण्यासाठी, योजनेचे खंड ५ मध्ये मंडळाची कार्ये विशद करण्यात आलेली आहेत. ती सर्वसाधारणपणे खालीलप्रमाणे आहेत.

अ) कोणत्याही कारखान्यातील किंवा आस्थापनेतील सुरक्षा विषयक काम/राखण करण्यासाठी मंडळाच्या नोंदणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षकांच्या पर्याप्त पुरवठयाची खात्री करून घेणे.

 ब) मडळाच्या नोदणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षकांच्या नोदवहीवरील संख्या आणि मंडळाच्या नोदणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षकांच्या संख्येत वाढ किंवा घट निर्धारित करणे आणि तिचे पुनर्विलोकन वेळोवेळी करती रहाणे.

क) नोंदणीकृत प्रमुख नियोक्त्यांची नोंद ठेवणे, तिचे समायोजन करणे व परिक्षण करणे. (सदर नोंदवही वेबसाईटवर उपलब्ध आहे.)

ड) मंडळातील नोंदणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षकांची नोंदणीची नोंदवही/अभिलेख ठेवणे,(सदर नोंदवही वेबसाईटवर उपलब्ध आहे.)

इ) नोंदणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षकांच्या वैद्यकीय सेवांसह कल्याणासाठीच्या सेवांसाठी निधीच्या उपलब्धतेस अधिन राहून तरतूद करणे.

फ) या योजनेचा खर्चे, बेतने बसुली यासाठी नोंदणीकृत प्रमुख नियोबत्यांकडून अंशदान आणि या योजनेखालील इतर अंशदाने वसुल करणे.

ग) मंडळाच्या नोंदणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षकांना वेतन व इतर भत्ते संवितरित करणे.

ह) मंडळाच्या नोंदणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षकांसाठी शारीरिक प्रशिक्षणाची सोय करण्याकरीता पुरेशा पायाभुत सविधांची तरतुद करणे.

य) नेांद्रणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षकांसाठी भविष्य निर्वाह निधी आणि उपदान निधी घटीत करणे, अञा निधीचे परिरक्षण करणे व त्यांचे प्रशासन करणे आणि सर्व सुरक्षा रक्षकांना कर्मचारी राज्य विमा योजना लागु करण्याची निश्चिती करणे,आणि योजनेतील सर्व तरतदींची अंमलबजावणी करणे.

७. नोंदणी:- अहवाल साली ४३ मुख्य मालक आणि १८५ सुरक्षा रक्षक मंडळात नोंदीत झाले. अहवाल वर्ष अखेरीस एकूण २९०८ मुख्य मालक तसेच ४८५८५ सुरक्षा रक्षक नोंदीत होते. याशिवाय सूट प्राप्त सुरक्षा रक्षकांचे १३७ मुख्य मालक अहवाल काळात मंडळात नोंदीत होते.

८. **गंडळाच्या बैठका :**- अहवाल साली एकसदस्यीय गंडळाच्या एकूण पाच बैठका झालेल्या असून त्यामध्ये गंडळाने महत्त्वपूर्ण निर्णय घेतलेले आहेत.

९. कल्याणकारी तरतूरी:- योजनेचे खंड ४० मध्ये तरतूर केल्यानुसार, मंडळाच्या नोंदणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षकांना निरिनराळे फायदे, सुविधा व सुखसोयी पुरविण्यासाठी मंडळ नोंदणीकृत मुख्य मालकांकडून, सुरक्षा रक्षकांच्या वेतनावर ४६.७५% लेव्ही वसुल करते. सदर लेव्हीची विगतवारी खाळीळप्रमाणे आहे.

मंडळातर्फे ज्या कल्याणकारी योजना रावविल्या जातात त्याबद्दलची माहिती थोडक्यात दिली आहे.

- **९.१. भविष्य निर्वाह निष्टी :-** योजनेचे खंड ४१ मधील तरतूदीनुसार, मंडळाने नोंदणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षकांसाठी मंडळाची अंशदायी भविष्य निर्वाह निष्टी योजना तयार केली असून ती सन १९८१ पासून लागू केलेली आहे. त्यासाठी सुरक्षा रक्षकांच्या वेतनातून दरमहा १२ टक्के हिस्सा कपात करण्यात येतो व तेवढाच हिस्सा मंडळ लेव्हीमधून जमा करते. नोंदीत सुरक्षा रक्षकांचा दरमहा जमा होणारी भविष्य निर्वाह निधीची रक्कम राष्ट्रीयकृत बँकेमध्ये गुंतविण्यात येते. अहवाल वर्ष अखेरीस राजीनामा देऊन/निवृत्त झालेल्या सुरक्षा रक्षकांना, भविष्य निर्वाह निधीची एकूण रक्कम रु.७,९९,८०,७३५.०० अदा करण्यात आली.
- **९.२. उपदान:** सामाजिक सुरक्षेचा भाग म्हणून नोंदीत सुरक्षा रक्षकांना, ते राजीनामा दिल्यावर किंवा सेवानिवृत्त झाल्यानंतर संबंधितांना मंडळाकडून उपदान दिले जाते. अहवाल साली सुरक्षा रक्षकांना उपदानापोटी रु. १,९५,६३,२८७.०० इतकी रक्कम वाटण्यात आले.
- **९.३. सानुग्रहअनुदान:** सुरक्षा रक्षक बोनस कायद्याच्या क्क्षेत येत नसल्याने त्यांच्यासाठी मंडळाने योजलेली सानुग्रह अनुदानाची योजना देखील महत्त्वाची कल्याणकारी योजना आहे. त्यासाठी मंडळाने प्रत्येक नोंदणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षकाला त्यांच्या वार्षिक मिळकतीवर ८.३३% प्रमाणे सानुग्रह अनुदान म्हणून सन १९८१ पासून देण्याचे ठरविले व तशी लेव्हीमध्ये ८.३३% टक्के इतकी तरतूद करण्यात आली आहे. तथापि, मंडळाने सन १९९३-९४ पासून सुरक्षा रक्षकांना १०.०० टक्के दराने सानुग्रह अनुदानाचे वाटप करण्याचा निर्णय घेतला आहे. त्यानुसार अहवाल वर्षी सुरक्षा रक्षकांना १० टक्के दराने सानुग्रह अनुदान वाटप करण्यात आले. त्यापोटी मंडळ रु.१०,६४,८५,५८८.०० इतकी रक्कम सुरक्षा रक्षकांना दिवाळी २०११ पूर्वी वाटप करण्यात आली.
- **९.४. रजेचा पगार:** मंडळाने प्रत्येक नोंदणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षकांना सन १९८१ पासून दर वर्षी त्यांच्या वार्षिक मिळकतीवर ६% प्रमाणे रजेच्या पगाराचा मोबदला देण्याचे ठरविले. अहवाल साली सुरक्षा रक्षकांना रजेच्या पगारापोटी रु. ६,३७,६४,७०६.०० वाटपाची देय रक्कम होती. ही रक्कम मे, २०११ मध्ये वाटप करण्यात आली.
- **९.५. भरपगारी सुट्ट्या :-** योजनेच्या खंड २३ मध्ये तरतूद केल्याप्रमाणे नोंदणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षकांना वर्षातील राष्ट्रीय दिन व महत्त्वाच्या सणांसाठी चार (४) भरपगारी सुट्ट्या दिल्या

जातात. मंडळातर्फे नोंदणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षकांना खालील भरपगारी सुङ्घा निश्चित करण्यात आल्या असन, त्यांच्या वार्षिक मिळकतीवर १% दराने मोबदला देण्यात येतो.

अहवाली वर्षी नोंदणीकृत सुरक्षा रक्षकांना भरपगारी सुङ्घांबद्दल रु. १,०६,२७,४५१.०० वाटपास देय रक्कम होती. ही रक्कम में, २०११ मध्ये वाटप करण्यात आली.

९.६ कामगार राज्य विमा योजना :- दि. ०१.०१.१९८८ पासून कामगार विमा कायदा व योजनेत मंडळाचा अंतर्भाव झाल्यापासून त्या योजनेअंतर्गत असलेले फायदे सुरक्षा रक्षकांना कामगार राज्य विमा महामंडळामार्फत मिळू लागले आहेत.

तथापि,ठाणे जिल्ह्यातील काही तालुक्यांचा कामगार विमा योजनेमध्ये अंतर्भाव होत नाही व सदरची योजना लागु नसल्याने सदर विभागात कार्यरत असलेल्या नोंदीत सरक्षा रक्षकांना कामगार नुकसान भरपाई कायद्यांतर्गत असलेले फायदे दिले जातात आणि वैद्येकीय सवलती मंडळाच्या ठरावानुसार दिल्या जातात.

९.७. गणवेश: - सुरुवातीला, मंडळ सुरक्षा रक्षकांना गणवेशाच्या किंमतीएवढे कर्ज मंजुर करून गणवेश पुरवित असे आणि त्यांचे हप्ते मासिक पगारातन वसल केले जात.

सुरक्षा रक्षकांनी आर्थिक स्थिती लक्षात घेऊन मंडळाने दि.१७ एप्रिल, १९८६ रोजी झालेल्या ५० व्या बैठकीमध्ये निर्णय घेतला की लेव्हीमध्ये तरतूद करुन सुरक्षा रक्षकांना २ वर्षातून एकदा २ जोडी गणवेश मोफत पुरविला जावा. त्याप्रमाणे हा खर्च भागविण्यासिठी दि.०१.०४.१९८६ पासन लेव्ही ४ टक्क्यांनी वाढविण्यात आली. अहवाल साली एकुण ४१७० सरक्षा रक्षकांना 'बाटा' कंपनीचे चामडी बुट मोफत वाटप करण्यात आले.

- **९.८ पावसाळी गणवेश व हिवाळी स्वेटर्स :** मंडळ सुरक्षा रक्षकांना चार वर्षांतून एकदा पावसाळी गणवेश म्हणजे रेनकोट, टोपी, गमबूट आणि हिवाळी स्वेटर्स मोफत पुरविते. अहवाल वर्षी मंडळाने १५३८ सरक्षा रक्षकांना पावसाळी गणवेशाचे वाटप केले. तसेच अहवाल वर्षी ११०४ सुरक्षा रक्षकांना हिवाळी स्वेटर्सचे वाटप केले.
- **९.९ वैद्यकीय फायदे:-** सुरक्षा रक्षक मंडळाच्या कार्यक्षेत्रामधील ज्या विभागास कामगार राज्य विमा योजना लागू नाही, तेथील नोंदीत सुरक्षा रक्षकांना मंडळाच्या ठरावानुसार वैद्यकीय फायदे दिले जातात.

मंडळाच्या तारापूर शाखे अंतर्गत काम करणाऱ्या सुरक्षा रक्षकांना, कामगार राज्य विमा योजना लाग होत नसल्यामळे त्यांना तारापुर येथील एका खाजगी दवाखान्यामार्फत मोफत वैद्यकीय सुविधा पुरविण्यात येतात.

९.१० कामगार नुकसान भरपाई:- ज्या सुरक्षा रक्षकांना कामगार राज्य विमा लागू नाही, अशा सुरक्षा रक्षकांना कामगार नुकसान भरपाई कायदा अंतर्गत फायदे दिले जातात.

१०. अपघात विमा योजना :- मंडळाने सुरक्षा रक्षकांकरीता दि.०१.०१.१९९७ पासून अपघात विमा योजना लागू केलेली आहे. अहवाल साली अपघातांमध्ये निधन झालेल्या एकूण ११ सुरक्षा रक्षकांचे वारसांना मंडळाने विमा कंपनीकडून रु.३३,००,०००.०० इतकी रक्कम मिळवून दिली.

११. वेतन:-

एकसदस्यीय मंडळाने दि. १०.२.२००९ रोजीच्या बैठकीत निर्णय घेऊन नोंदीत सुरक्षा रक्षकांचे महागाई भत्त्यामध्ये वाढ केली. ही वाढ दि. ०१.०१.२००९ पासून लागू करण्यात आली आहे. तद्नंतर एकसदस्यीय मंडळाने दि. ८.२.२०१० रोजीच्या बैठकीत निर्णय घेऊन नोंदीत सुरक्षा रक्षकांच्या वेतन, महागाई भत्ता व घरभाडे भत्ता यामध्ये वाढ केलेली आहे. ही वाढ दि.१.१.२०११ पासून लागू केलेली आहे. त्याचा तपशील पुढीलप्रमाणे :-

1. PREFACE :-

1.1 This is the Thirtieth Annual Report of the Security Guards Board For Brihanmumbai & Thane District, which is submitted to the Government under Section 8(3) of the Maharashtra Private Security Guards (Regulation of Employment & Welfare) Act, 1981. A review of the implementation of the Private Security Guards (Regulation of Employment & Welfare) Scheme, 1981 by the Board is taken herein.

1.2 The certificate of the Statutory Auditors appointed by the Government, the Income and Expenditure Statement and the Balance Sheet for the year 2010-2011 are enclosed herewith.

2. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE BOARD :-

The Security Guards Board For Brihanmumbai & Thane District has been established under Section 6(1) of the Maharashtra Private Security Guards (Regulation of Employment & Welfare) Act, 1981. The Board has been constituted by the Government of Maharashtra, Industries, Energy & Labour Deptt. Vide Notification No.SGA-1081/(154)/Lab-12, dtd. 16th July, 1981. The actual working of the Board commenced only from 1st October, 1981.

3. CONSTITUTION OF THE BOARD :-

3.1 The Board is a Tripartite Institution, on which representatives of Principal Employer and Security Guards and Government Representatives are nominated by the Government. State Government Nominee has been appointed as Chairman of the Board.

3.2 The One Man Board has been reconstituted by the Government of Maharashtra, Industries, Energy & Labour Department vide its Notification No. SGA-1507/(83)/Lab-5, dated 16.10.2007.

3.3 The name of the members of the Board and other details as existing at the end of the reporting period i.e. 31.3.2011 are shown at the beginning of the report.

4. SECURITY GUARDS ACT, IT'S OBJECTS AND APPLICATION:

4.1 The Maharashtra Private Security Guards (Regulation of Employment & Welfare) Act, 1981,

received assent of the President of India, on 24^{th} September, 1981 and was first published by the Government of Maharashtra, vide Maharashtra Government Gazette, Part IV, Ext.on25th September, 1981.

4.2 PREAMBLE/OBJECT OF THE ACT :-

of the Factory or Establishment.

The Act for regulating the employment of Private Security Guards, employed in Factories & Establishments in the State of Maharashtra and for making better provisions for their terms and conditions of the employment & Welfare through the Establishment of a Board. therefore, and for matters connected therewith.

4.3 Application of the Act: The said Act is applicable to the whole of the State of Maharashtra. However initially the scope of the Act was Restricted only to Brihanmumbai and Thane District. The Act applies to the persons who work as Security Guards in any factory or Establishment through Agencies but it does not apply to persons, who are direct and regular employees

4.4 Exemption from the provisions of the Act: As per the directives of Hon'ble Court, the Government has adopted a policy to grant an exemption to the Private Security Guards for a period of 3 years under Section 23 of the Maharashtra Private Security Guards (Regulation of Employment & Welfare) Act, 1981 on certain terms and conditions.

SCHEME FRAMED UNDER THE ACT :-

For the purpose of ensuring an adequate supply and full and proper utilization of Security Guards in Factories & Establishments and generally for making better provision for the terms and conditions of employment, the State Government under Section 3(1) of the said Act has framed a Scheme, known as The Private Security Guards (Regulation of Employment & Welfare) Scheme, 1981.

The Scheme applies to the registered Security Guards in any Factory or Establishment in the area of Brihanmumbai & Thane District and the Registered Employers who are employing them. Clause 14 & 15 of the Scheme came into force from 1st October, 1981, while the remaining Clauses of the Scheme came into force from 1st November, 1981. The implementation of the Scheme commenced from 1st October, 1981. The amended Scheme has came into force in the year 2002.

FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD :

For carrying out the objective of administering the Scheme set out in Clause 2 of the Scheme framed under the said Act, the functions of the Board are specified in Clause 5 of the Scheme. Those are as under in general.

 a) ensuring the adequate supply and full and proper utilization of registered Security Guards of the Board for the purpose of facilitating and doing Security.

b) determining and keeping under review the number of registered Security Guards of the Board from time to time on the registered or records and the increase or reduction to be made in a number of registered Security Guards of the Board.

c) Keeping, adjusting and maintaining the registered Principal Employers (the said register is maintained and is available on website of the Board).

d) Keeping, adjusting and maintaining from time to time such registers of registered Security Guards of the Board (the said register is maintained and is available on website of the Board). e) making provision subject of availability of funds for welfare of registered Security Guards of the Board including medical services.

 f) recovering from registered Principal Employers contribution in respect of the expenses of the Scheme, Wages, Levy and other contributions under the Scheme.

g) disbursing of wages and other allowances to registered Security Guards of the Board.

h) making adequate infrastructure to provide for the Physical Training facilities for the registered Security Guards of the Board.

i) maintaining and administering Provident Fund and Gratuity Fund for the registered Security Guards of the Board and to ensure that Employees' State Insurance Scheme is made applicable to all the Security Guards and to implement all the provisions of the Scheme.

7. REGISTRATION:

During the year under report, 43 Principal Employers and 185 Security Guards were registered. The total registration of the Principal Employers and Security Guards at the end of the year under report are 2908 and 48585 respectively. Apart from this 137 Principal Employers have been registered with the Board under exemption category, during the year under report,

8. BOARD MEETINGS:

The One Man Board held Five (5) meetings during the year under report, and the Board has taken some effective decisions.

WELFARE MEASURES :

As provided under Clause 40 of the Scheme, the Board collect the Levy @ 46.75% from the Registered Principal Employers on the Wages of Security Guards in order to provide various welfare benefits to the Registered Security Guards. The allocation of the Levy w.e.f. 1.2.1998 is as under:

The details of the various Welfare Measures (Schemes) implemented by the Board are given below in short.

9.1 Provident Fund: As provided under Clause 41 of the Scheme, the Board has formulated it's own contributory Provident Fund Scheme for the Registered Security Guards and made applicable from the year 1981. For this purpose, the Board deducts the contribution @ 12% from Wages of the Security Guards every month and an equal amount is contributed by the Board from the levy to his

Provident Fund Account. During the year under report an amount of Rs.7.99.80.535.00 was paid to Resigned/Retired Security Guards towards Provident Fund.

9.2 Gratuity: As a part of social security, the Board provides the benefit of Gratuity to the Registered Security Guards on their Resignation or Retirement. During the year under report an amount of Rs.1,95,63,287.00 was paid to Resigned/Retired Security Guards towards Gratuity.

9.3 Ex-gratia: The Scheme of Ex-gratia is another Welfare Measure for the Security Guards, who do not come under the purview of the payment of Bonus Act. The Board approved for the payment of Ex-gratia @ 8.33% of the annual earnings of each Security Guards, since 1981. For this purpose the Board has made a provision @ 8.33% in the levy. However, the Board has taken a decision in the year 1993-94 to pay the Ex-gratia @ 10% to the Registered Security Guards. Accordingly, during the year under Report, an Ex-gratia @ 10% has been paid to the Security Guards. An amount of Rs.10,64,85,588.00 was disbursed to the Security Guards before Diwali 2011.

9.4 <u>Leave With Wages</u>:- The Board has approved for payment of Leave with Wages @ 6% of the total earnings of each registered Security Guards since 1981. During the year under report, Security Guards were entitled for Leave With Wages amounting to Rs.6.37.64.706.00. This amount was disbursed to them in the Month of May, 2010.

9.5 Paid Holidays: Registered Security Guards are entitled for 4 (Four) Paid Holidays for National/Festival important days, during a year, as provided Under Clause 23 of the Scheme. The following Holidays were sanctioned to the Registered Security Guards and they are paid the compensatory amount @ 1% on their earnings during the year in lieu of paid Holidays.

1. REPUBLIC DAY	 26TH JANUARY
2. MAHARASHTRA DAY	 1^{ST} MAY
3. INDEPENDENCE DAY	 15^{TH} AUGUST
4. DIWALI	 1ST DAY.

During the year under report, Security Guards were entitled for Paid Holidays amounting to Rs.1,06,27,451.00. This amount was disbursed to them in the Month of May, 2011.

9.6 EMPLOYEES' STATE INSURANCE SCHEME :-

Board is covered under E.S.I. Act and Scheme w.e.f. 1.1.1988 and Security Guards are getting benefits as per the said Scheme from E.S.I. Corporation.

However, some of the Talukas in Thane District are not covered under E.S.I. Scheme and as the said Scheme is not applicable to the registered Security Guards working in these Talukas, they are provided with the benefits as per the Workmen Compensation Act and Medical Benefits as per the Board's Resolution.

9.7 <u>Uniform</u>: The Board was providing Uniforms to the Security Guards by granting the loan equal to the cost of the Uniform which was Recovered in installment from their Monthly Wages. Considering the economic conditions of Security Guards the Board took up the Issue in it's 50th Meeting

held on 17th April, 1986 and decided to provide 2 sets of Uniform free of cost to the Security Guards once in two Years by making provisions in Levy. Accordingly the Levy was increased by 4% w.e.f. 1.4.1986 to meet this expenditure. During the Year under report 4170 Security Guards were provided Leather Shoes of 'Bata' Company, free of cost.

9.8 Monsoon Wear & Winter Wear (Sweater): The Board provides free of cost, Rainy Wears i.e. Raincoat, Cap, Gumboot and Winter Sweaters to the Security Guards once in four years. During the year under report, the Monsoon Wears were provided to 1538 Security Guards and during the year under report, the Winter Wears (Sweater) were provided to 1104 Security Guards.

9.9 Medical Benefit: Medical Benefits are provided to the registered Security Guards as per the Board Resolution, where the E.S.I. Scheme is not applicable. The Board is providing free Medical treatment to the Security Guards working in Tarapur Area through one Hospital at Tarapur.

9.10 Workmen Compensation: The benefits are given under Workmen Compensation Act to the registered Security Guards, which are not covered under E.S.I. Scheme.

10. PERSONAL ACCIDENT INSURANCE SCHEME :-

The Security Guards are covered under the Personal Accident Insurance Scheme w.e.f. 1.1.1997. During the year under report, an amount of Rs. 33,00,000.00 has been received by the Board from the Insurance Company and paid to the Nominees of 11 Security Guards.

11. WAGES :-

The Board in its Meeting held on 10.2.2009 has revised the wages and allowances of Security Guards w.e.f. 1.1.2009. Further, the Board in it's Meeting held on 8.2.2010 has revised the Wages, Dearness Allowance and House Rent Allowance of the Security Guards w.e.f. 1.1.2011. The details are given below:--

12. ANNUAL TURN OVER :-

12.1 <u>WAGES</u>:- During the year under report Rs.1,71,62,66,570.00 were disbursed by way of wages and allowances to the Security Guards. The Wages are generally disbursed between 1^{st} to 12^{th} of every month.

12.2 <u>LEVY</u>: The Levy amount realised from the Registered Principal Employers was Rs.48,89,05,619.00 during the year under report.

12.3 Administrative Levy @ 3% from Private Security Agencies: The Administrative levy @ 3% amounting to Rs.1,57,70,061.00 was received during the year under report from the Security Agencies in respect of exempted Private Security Guards.

13. PROSECUTIONS:

The Inspectors of the Board have filed 94 prosecutions under Clause 13 and Clause 25 of the Private Security Guards (Regulation of Employment & Welfare) Scheme, 2002, during the year under report.

The details of number of prosecutions pending at beginning of the year, filed during the year and pending at the end of the year is as follows:-

14. BRANCH OFFICES :-

The Jurisdiction of the Board is Brihan Mumbai & Thane District and therefore to avoid any inconvenience to the registered Principal Employers and also to registered Security Guards at the distant places, the Board has opened branches at Vashi, Tarapur and Kalyan. Because of the Branch Offices, the Board can promptly look in to the grievances of the Registered Principal Employers as well as the Registered Security Guards.

15. TRAINING CENTRE :-

In order to provide Trained Security Guards to the Registered Principal Employers, the Board has started its own Training Centre w.e.f. 19th February, 1996. The Registered Security Guards are given a Week's basic Training on Security and they are paid "Daily Allowance" during the Training period.

16. PARADE :-

The Platoon of the Security Guards of the Board is participating in the Parade organized by the Govt. of Maharashtra at Shivaji Park, Mumbai, every year on the occasion of 26th January "Republic Day" and 1st May "Maharashtra Day", since the year 2001.

17. ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE BOARD :-

3) This is the First Board which has started its own Website (www.securityguardsboard.in)

4) The Board is making efforts at the level of the Government to get the Office Premises on outright basis.
