

L. A. BILL No. XXXVI OF 2026.

A BILL

further to amend the Maharashtra Industrial Development Act, 1961.

(As passed by the Legislative Assembly on the 2nd July, 2026.)

(As passed by the Legislative Council on the 7th July, 2026.)

WHEREAS both Houses of the State Legislature were not in session ;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Maharashtra was satisfied that circumstances existed which rendered it necessary for him to take immediate action further to amend the Maharashtra Industrial Development Act, 1961, for the purposes hereinafter appearing; and, therefore, promulgated the Maharashtra Industrial Development (Amendment) Ordinance, 2026 on the 16th June 2026 ;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to replace the said Ordinance, by an Act of the State Legislature ; it is hereby enacted in the Seventy-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Maharashtra Industrial Development (Amendment) Act, 2026.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 16th June 2026.

Amendment of section 22 of Mah. III of 1962.	2. In section 22 of the Maharashtra Industrial Development Act, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Act”), in sub-section (2), for the words “rupees seventy-five crores” the words “rupees six thousand crores” shall be substituted. Repeal of Mah. Ord. VII of 2026 and saving.	3. (1) The Maharashtra Industrial Development (Amendment) Ordinance, 2026, is hereby repealed. (2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken (including any notification or order issued) under the corresponding provisions of the principal Act, as amended by the said Ordinance, shall be deemed to have been done, taken or, as the case may be, issued under the corresponding provisions of the principal Act, as amended by this Act.
