to repeal the Maharashtra Industrial Relations Act.

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal the Maharashtra Industrial Relations Act; it is hereby enacted in the Seventy-seventh Year of the Republic of India, as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Maharashtra Industrial Relations (Repeal) Act, 2026. Short title.

2. The Maharashtra Industrial Relations Act is hereby repealed.

Savings.	3. (1) Notwithstanding repeal of the Maharashtra Industrial Relations Act, the pending proceedings thereunder on the date of commencement of this Act, as well as the implementation of existing settlements, court orders and awards alongwith the rights and liabilities arising therefrom shall be continued and disposed of in accordance with the provisions of the Maharashtra Industrial Relations Act, as if this Act had not been enacted.	XI of 1947.
	(2) The provisions of section 7 of the Maharashtra General Clauses Act, shall apply on repeal of the Maharashtra Industrial Relations Act.	XI of 1947.
